

Council of Halifax Centre - Minutes of Meeting 13 May 2016

1. Welcome & Introductions

Paul Gray welcomed members. He asked if members had other items to add to the agenda. Agenda was approved as circulated.

It was moved by Dave Chapman and seconded by Jim Millar that the agenda be approved as circulated. CARRIED.

ONGOING ITEMS

2. Upcoming Meeting Dates & Guest Speakers

Paul Gray noted a full slate of speakers for the remainder of the year. He is in discussions with New Brunswick regarding the Maritime Tour of Dr. David Levy. David Chapman has been in contact with the Halifax Central Library to determine their interest in co-sponsoring the presentation; he requested the Paul O'Regan Hall for the presentation; he was promised a response in a couple of weeks.

Paul Gray has also been in contact with Randall Rosenfeld to determine his willingness and availability for a presentation here in April/May 2017.

3. Outreach

Paul Heath noted there are several requests for presentations and invited members to assist. Halifax Centre is also invited to the Science Teachers Conference on October 28, 2016 at Halifax West High School, 7:30 AM – 4 PM. The cost of having a table at the booth has gone down considerably compared to past years (\$30.00 for not for profit organizations, down from ~ \$200.00 in past years).

4. Sale of Dobsonian

No offers to purchase the Dobsonian have been received. Chris Young made a few suggestions on how we could go forward:

- 1. Buy a shed for it at SCO for approximately \$1,000.00, do upgrades and use it.
- 2. Let time pass and re-auction it with a lower minimum bid. The current minimum is the depreciated value which may not reflect the market value.
- 3. Let the NB Centre be included in the next auction or offer it for sale (delivery/pick-up distance is a factor in any sale).
- 4. Do homework on what it might sell for (i.e. watch Astro-Buy Sell, Cloudy-Nights, Astromart)

5. Sell on Kijiji.

It was moved by Quinn Smith and seconded by Paul Heath that the Dobsonian be posted for sale on Kijiji for \$1200.00.

Council discussed the price that should be quoted on Kijiji, and the method of delivery (i.e., meeting the buyer halfway if sold in Nova Scotia or New Brunswick). Following discussion, an amendment was proposed to the previous motion.

It was moved by Judy Black that an amendment to the previous motion be made and that the Dobsonian be posted for sale on Kijiji for \$1400.00 and that the person who posts the telescope has Council's approval to accept offers down to and including \$1200.00. CARRIED.

Paul Gray and Chris Young are to post the sale of the Dobsonian on Kijiji citing the price of \$1400.00 but have been approved to accept a bid as low as \$1200.00.

5. Council member Position Descriptions - Approval

Judy Black had pre-circulated the summary document for members' review. She proposed that Council approve the information in the Column entitled Roles/Tasks. Jim Millar noted that the Treasurer position was the only one that did not have term limits. He proposed the suggestion for a 3-year Term Limit for this position due to difficulty in recruitment.

6. Financial Concerns

Jim Millar contacted the Legal Information Society of Nova Scotia and was informed he required a tax lawyer or accountant. Consequently, he obtained advice from a Federal Crown Prosecutor who informed him that RASC Halifax

Centre does need to complete the CRA T2 form. Discussion ensued regarding acquiring assistance from an accountant with the first tax submission.
