1. Welcome & Introductions

Judy Black called the meeting to order at 6:28 PM, when a quorum had joined the Zoom meeting, and welcomed members. The meeting agenda was reviewed. Peter Hurley requested that changing further Board meetings start time to 7pm be added to the agenda. Paul Gray requested RASC calendars be added to agenda; it was agreed to add it before the deferred items as Item #17.

ONGOING ITEMS

2. Upcoming Meeting Dates & Guest Speakers

a) SMU Room Bookings

At this time, SMU is not in a position to offer meeting facilities in the Fall to external clients and will advise when the situation changes.

b) 2020 Meeting date confirmation:

There will likely be no Fall face-to-face meeting. Centre Members' meetings have been booked on the National Zoom account as webinars. The remaining Nova East talks will be hosted on the Centre Zoom account as meetings. The Centre Board of Directors meetings have been booked on the Centre Zoom account as meetings. See Agenda notes for dates and details.

The status of the September BBQ remains undetermined.

c) Guest Speakers and Ideas for Future Presentations

Nicole Mortillaro is scheduled guest speaker in September but may not be able to present. If that is the case, then Pat Kelly will present his Nova East talk scheduled for September 8 instead as the guest speaker at the Members' Meeting on September 12, 2020. Lauchie Scott is scheduled as the guest speaker in October. Glenn Roberts is scheduled as guest speaker in November. No guest speaker is booked for the December AGM but Luigi Gallo or graduate students are still a possibility.

d) OH Presentations

David Hoskin has agreed to make the OH presentation at the September meeting. There was some discussion whether there were still topics in the OH that didn't require full-length presentations. Presentations from other publications, or about how to use the RASC Calendar (perhaps at the December AGM), or about the Explore the Universe Guide or Skyways were also suggested as alternatives for presentation topics.

e) Start time of future Board of Directors Zoom meetings

It was agreed to change the start time of future Board Zoom meetings to 7:00 pm.

3. Report from National Council Representative

Pat Kelly indicated the next National Council meeting was scheduled for September 20, 2020. Two main topics for discussion are the RASC Bylaws and Constitution as well as a review of the Centre Manual prior to circulation to the Centres.

4. Outreach / Inreach

Paul Heath raised the question of whether there were suggestions of how to protect binocular and telescope eyepieces so that small outreach observing activities such as with scout groups could occur safely. There was much discussion but no resolution. Zoom will continue to be used for virtual observing and special astroimaging sessions.

International Observe the Moon Night occurs on September 26 this year. Peter Hurley raised the possibility of presenting a virtual Lunar Observing activity using a Zoom meeting similar to the session done by Blair MacDonald and Dave Chapman on April 29, 2020. He had approached Blair and Dave and they indicated interest and Judy Black has agreed to host the session, but Blair may not have a clear line-of-sight of the Moon until 10:00 pm from his location. Jerry Black is exploring whether he would have a line-of-sight earlier in the evening and that he could webcast an image. Dave Lane was suggested as another member who might be able to do this.

5. RASC-Halifax Centre Website

Judy Black reported that the September *What's Up?* had been added and the Nova East page had been updated.

6. Financial Update

Gregg Dill had emailed the Board on September 1 indicating he would be unable to attend the meeting on September 3. He indicated that we had a GIC due September 20 and asked if we wanted to cash it. He provided an unconfirmed renewal rate from TD Bank. He asked if we did reinvest it, did we want to increase the amount. He also asked about the timeline for SCO electrification, reported our current bank balance of \$8,088 with a \$500 cheque outstanding to Halley Davies for editing the 2015 GA videos. On September 2, Gregg emailed the Board to clarify that the \$500 cheque is off-set by a cheque from RASC as an in-out transaction, and to remind us that 2 additional GICs (\$4,000 each) were maturing in June 2021.

There was much discussion of the situation regarding bringing electrical power to SCO, reviewing what had been done, and what was required to proceed. There was also much discussion regarding the cost and how we might cover those costs. It was agreed there would be little benefit in re-investing the \$2,000 GIC and having the cash-on-hand would leave us better prepared to address funds required to proceed with SCO electrification.

It was moved by Peter Hurley and seconded by Paul Gray to cash the \$2,000 GIC due on September 20, 2020. CARRIED.

The conclusion reached was that we required a special meeting of the Board to address this question of SCO electrification as soon as possible, and that Gregg's attendance was essential.

Judy Black to contact Gregg Dill to determine dates/times he would be available for a special meeting and then call a special meeting of the Board to address how to proceed with the electrification of SCO and the associated funding requirements.

UPDATES / REPORTS

7. SCO Status

Following the discussion of the requirements associated with the electrification of SCO, there was further discussion of running conduit between the buildings. And of the need for propane and carbon monoxide sensor alarms in the warm room. And John pointed out that the single electrician quote he had obtained included all inspections required.

John Liddard indicated he had been doing some cleaning up in preparation for the BBQ and that some exterior painting was required. We agreed that he should proceed to make the necessary paint purchase.

It was moved by Paul Heath and seconded by Pat Kelly that funds up to \$50.00 be available to purchase a can of paint for SCO maintenance.

CARRIED.

It was pointed out that under the present Guidelines for the Use of SCO, only 10 people are permitted onsite at one time, and that we would need to revise the Guidelines to permit the BBQ. After further discussion, members agreed that we should cancel the BBQ for 2020.

8. Report: Nova East Planning Committee Meeting

An update from the Nova East Star Party Planning Committee was included as Agenda Note #2. Jenna Hinds at RASC will include the invitation to the September 8 edition of the Nova East Speaker Series with Pat Kelly's talk about Mars. Judy reminded us that there would be no revenues associated with t-shirt sales this year, as those wishing shirts would be arranging purchase and printing of the shirts themselves. Also, the deadline for the Astroimaging contest submission date had been changed to midnight September 18, 2020.

Paul Heath left the meeting at 8:10 PM.

9. Update: The Discovery Centre

Wayne Harasimovitch and Peter Hurley summarized their recent activities to foster collaboration with the Discovery Centre. The Discovery Centre opened to the public in mid-July, 9:00 am-12 noon and 1:00 pm-4:00 pm Thursday-Sunday, with rigourous controls and limitations on public movement through the facility. They are using themes every other weekend. On the weekend of September 26/27, because of International Observe the Moon Night on September 26, they have invited us to participate in an Astronomy Theme with them that weekend. Wayne, Peter and Tony Schellinck met with Japna Sidhu-Brar of Discovery Centre in a Zoom meeting on August 26 to explore options. Wayne and Peter then made a site visit to the Discovery Centre on August 29 to review their safety and security protocols and to discuss traffic flow and the location of activity stations and the use of tables and barriers to assist with distancing. Wayne and Peter described 3 activities that they were proposing: Information table with starfinders, binocular/telescope display and a game "Celestial Pursuits". It was agreed that they would present these at the Members' Meeting on September 12 and ask for volunteers.

10. Update: Library

Wayne Harasimovitch reported that the library would remain closed as long as COVID-19 restrictions kept SMU closed to students and outside groups.

11. Report: Binocular Flyer

Pat Kelly will report back next meeting.

12. Update: 2015 GA Video

Judy Black reported that the work had been completed, the videos were all loaded onto the RASC Halifax YouTube account. She noted that the payment of \$500 to Halley Davies appeared in the email from Gregg Dill as an in-out transaction. She referred the Board to Agenda Note #3 for a list of the completed videos and the number of views each had received.

13. Update: Evaluation of the Zoom Account

Judy Black referred the Board to Agenda Note #4. It was agreed that the Zoom account was a good investment. A complete report would be presented at the November Board meeting.

14. Update: Service Award Nominations

Judy Black requested an update as to the status of the nominations suggested at a previous meeting. Pat Kelly pointed out that the Fellowship of the RASC Award nomination was a National activity. Mary Lou indicated that preparing a National Award nomination was a lot of work and asked who was in the Awards Committee Chair. There were two nominations from this Centre; she suggested that nothing was likely to be done before the October Board meeting and we would need a nudge from the President at that point.

NEW BUSINESS

15. Nomination Committee Formation

Judy Black reminded the Board of the upcoming AGM in December and referred members to Agenda Note #5 regarding the Bylaw requirement to form a Nomination Committee. This Committee will need to make a call for nominations by October 1. She asked if Board members would consider being a member of the Nomination Committee or could they recommend someone from the Centre. She asked members to consider whether they will re-offer to sit on the Board. That will need to be communicated to the Nomination Committee. At this point, we know that we will need a new Nova Notes editor, as Charles White has indicated he is stepping down as of December 31. A new National Council member is required as Pat Kelly is retiring from that role; however, Pat agreed he would remain as a Halifax centre director. It was pointed out that we should endeavour to recruit some younger members to the Board. Dave Chapman and Chris Young were suggested as possible Nomination Committee members.

16. Inclusivity and Diversity Committee – Sensitivity Training

Judy Black had circulated to the Board an invitation she had received from the RASC Presidents List to a Zoom meeting training session. The invitation, from the Canadian Centre for Gender and Sexual Diversity in partnership with the RASC Inclusivity and Diversity Committee, was to a Gender Diversity and Sexuality training Zoom session on August 22, 2020. Four Halifax Centre members participated (total 23 participants including the 2 presenters) and they had the information should be shared with our membership.

Paul Heath, who is a member of the I&D Committee, gave Board members a background to the training session. He indicated that further training sessions were in preparation on other I&D issues. The session invitation had been intended for Boards, but some Centres had distributed it to Members, others had not circulated it. Judy proposed to circulate a copy of the session to our Board members when it was available. It was agreed to pass the information on to our membership at the Centre Members' meeting.

17. RASC 2021 Calendars

Given the pandemic, the method of distribution and sale were discussed. Judy had confirmed with Gregg Dill prior to this meeting that an e-transfer to the treasurer similar to that done for Nova East was acceptable. He would collect the funds and the mailing address attached to the payment made. Paul Gray agreed to place the order for 40 calendars and Judy Black agreed to pick them up at the Dartmouth printers. Wayne Harasimovitch agreed to do the packing and mailing on our behalf.

Every year, up to 3 Halifax Centre members (with the President as an *ex officio* member) must comprise a Nominating Committee. Their role is to develop a slate of officers and appointees to the required positions within the RASC Halifax Centre as per *Policy B2: Terms of Reference – Ordinary Committees of RASC Halifax Centre*.
